Head Coach - Women's & Girls Cricket

Stewarts Melville CC, one of Scotland's largest Cricket Clubs, based in Edinburgh, is looking to recruit a part time Head Coach for our Womens & Girls Cricket Programme for summer 2020.

As part of our continued commitment to the development of female Cricket, we are now seeking an experienced and inspiring Head Coach who has the skills and flexibility required to make a significant contribution to take our players / teams forward. There will be a key focus on developing players and the pathway for those aged 5-18, covering all aspects from introduction to Cricket to our Senior Women's team – current Scottish Premier League champions. Role – reporting to the Club's Juniors Convener - continue to grow female Cricket at Stewarts Melville CC and ensure a robust pathway in place to allow Girls (aged 5-18) to participate actively in Cricket. Will be responsible for organisation and leading delivery of Club's Female Cricket programme from April – August 2020.

The part-time role will require working c20 hours per week, including midweek evenings plus Sundays and Midweek daytimes (with local Schools). Match day Coaching of all female teams required. The role will also include some Coaching with Boys Junior teams / age groups.

Summer Camps – the Club holds 2 full week Summer Camps in July and August – the job holder would be expected to lead Coaching of Girls groups at these Camps.

Required Skills:-

- Experienced and Inspiring Coach who can lead by example – proven track record of leading and delivering structured Cricket programmes – at all levels of Cricket for adults and children
- Strong Planning and Organisational skills – evidence of leading female teams / programmes and input to a Club strategy to be a leading Club for female Cricket
- Excellent Communicator who can evidence an ability to communicate / interact well with a broad range of stakeholders, including volunteers and local schools
- Experience of leading Coaching of teams / programmes in more established female Cricket structures / environments would be an advantage
- Energetic and enthusiastic leader, with strong interpersonal skills, who can recruit and retain Girls in Cricket

- Experience evidenced of growing player base, including player recruitment strategies
- A team player who can develop strong and effective working relationships with a range of internal and external partners
- Ability to lead an experienced Coaching team as well as working closely with peers
- Must be flexible around working hours – weekday evenings, Sundays and midweek daytimes
- Passion for growing the female game and developing Girls Cricket at all age groups

Other Requirements:-

- Applicants must be in possession of a UKCC Level 2 Cricket Coaching certificate, or overseas equivalent recognised for UK Border Agency Tier 5 purposes.
- Applicants must hold PVG Scheme membership or equivalent.
