## Delivery process

32-hour full school programme

Play - (24 hours) practical lessons, 6 sessions 1 hour each 4 classes

Inspire - (2 hours) induction/school assembly

Lead - (2 hours) teachers CPD

Compete - Intra/Inter school competitions

Pathway - (2 hours) parent/community engagement - ASG assistance

Delivered by 4-6 coaches during term 3 and 4
